



The study was conducted for CNN via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from October 24, 2018 to October 29, 2018 among a sample of **1,004** respondents who live in Tennessee. The landline total respondents were **404** and there were **600** cell phone respondents. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is +/-3.7 at the 95% confidence level, for results among the 871 registered voters it is +/-4.0, and for results among the 764 likely voters it is +/-4.3. MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of 1,004 adults who live in Tennessee were interviewed by telephone by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish. Among the entire sample, 25% described themselves as Democrats, 31% described themselves as Republicans, and 44% described themselves as independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect Census figures for gender, race, age, education, state region, and telephone usage.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of \pm 3.7 percentage points. For the sample of 871 registered voters, it is \pm 4.0 percentage points. For the sample of 764 likely voters, it is \pm 4.3 percentage points.

Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with enough unweighted cases to produce a sampling error of +/-8.5 percentage points or less once adjusted for design effect. Some subgroups represent too small a share of the state population to produce crosstabs with an acceptable sampling error. Interviews were conducted among these subgroups, but results for groups with a design-effect adjusted sampling error larger than +/-8.5 percentage points are not displayed and instead are denoted with "N/A".
