

## CNN 2019 SOTU Reaction Poll (Poll 3)

The study was conducted for CNN via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted on February 05, 2019 among a sample of 584 respondents who watched the presidential speech. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is $+/-5.4$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is 1.80 .

Survey respondents were first interviewed as part of a random national sample conducted January 30-February 02, 2019 on the CNN February 2019 Tracking Poll as well as on the SSRS Omnibus from January 29-February 03, 2019. Respondents were also recruited via the SSRS Online Probability Panel from January 29-February 04, 2019. This panel is constructed from a random sample of the U.S. adult population recruited through the SSRS Omnibus, an overlapping dual-frame (cell phone and landline) RDD telephone survey. In those interviews, respondents indicated they planned to watch the President's State of the Union speech and were willing to be re-interviewed after the speech. Unless otherwise noted, results beginning with the March 31-April 2, 2006 survey and ending with the April 22-25, 2017 survey are from surveys conducted by ORC International. Results before March 31, 2006 are from surveys conducted by Gallup.

## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of 584 adults were interviewed by telephone nationwide by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish. Interviews were conducted February 05, 2019. Among the entire sample, 22\% described themselves as Democrats, 42\% described themselves as Republicans, and 35\% described themselves as independents or members of another party.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-5.4$ percentage points.
Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with a minimum $n=125$ unweighted cases. While interviews were conducted among a representative sample of the adult population of the United States, results for subgroups with fewer than $n=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "N/A" because they are too small to be projectable to their true values in the population.
