

The study was conducted for CNN via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from March 14 to March 17, 2019 among a sample of 1,003 respondents. The landline total respondents were $\mathbf{3 4 8}$ and there were $\mathbf{6 5 5}$ cell phone respondents. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is $+/-\mathbf{3 . 8}$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The design effect is $\mathbf{1 . 4 8}$. Unless otherwise noted, results beginning with the March 31-April 2, 2006 survey and ending with the April 22-25, 2017 survey are from surveys conducted by ORC International. ## MORE ON METHODOLOGY

A total of $\mathbf{1 , 0 0 3}$ adults were interviewed by telephone nationwide by live interviewers calling both landline and cell phones. Interviews were conducted in English and Spanish. Among the entire sample, 32\% described themselves as Democrats, $\mathbf{2 5 \%}$ described themselves as Republicans, and $\mathbf{4 4 \%}$ described themselves as independents or members of another party.

All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect national Census figures for gender, race, age, education, region of country, and telephone usage.

Results for the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $+/-3.8$ percentage points. For the sample of 914 registered voters it is $+/-4.0$ percentage points. For the subset of 456 Democrats and Democratic-leaning independents, it is +/-5.7 percentage points, and for the 448 Republicans and Republican-leaning independents, it is $+/-5.5$ percentage points.

Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with a minimum $n=125$ unweighted cases. While interviews were conducted among a representative sample of the adult population of the United States, results for subgroups with fewer than $\mathrm{n}=125$ unweighted cases are not displayed and instead are denoted with "N/A" because they are too small to be projectable to their true values in the population.
