Dear Mr. Cipollone:

On April 2, 2019, Chairman Elijah Cummings issued a subpoena to compel the deposition of Carl Kline in the Chairman's investigation into security clearance processes at the White House. The Chairman issued this subpoena despite Mr. Kline's willingness to testify voluntarily. I anticipate that Chairman Cummings will initiate contempt proceedings against Mr. Kline as soon as next Tuesday.

To avoid unnecessary conflict between Congress and the Executive Branch and to deescalate Chairman Cummings's orchestrated inter-branch confrontation, I write to ask whether Mr. Kline would agree to appear for a voluntary transcribed interview with Committee staff on April 30, or May 1, 2019.

Thank you for your attention to this request. I look forward to hearing back from you.
